Easter Update

As prices continue to rise, we see more and more people either homeless or struggling to cope, although they say it is easier now the weather is improving. We often welcome almost 100 adults to our weekly hot lunch and takeaway food, some queuing for three hours before we open.

They also have access to our Well-being Counsellor, our hairdresser, Hepatitis C checks, various health checks, drug and alcohol support via Horizon, and support from Empowerment.

We were fortunate in being successful in our bid for a grant from DWP to offer warm clothing items, and now have a stock which should last for a few months.

Unfortunately, our core fund, which should cover our running costs of £350 a week, is running low. If you would like to support our work by committing to a small monthly standing order (£2 a month would be great) these are the bank details: COMFORT C.A.F.E. Co-operative Bank
